The campaign theme. “*Jesus. All about life*” is based on John 10:10 *I have come that you may have life — life to the full.*

The aim is that 90 per cent of people in the metropolitan area will see adverts up to 10 times.

Whether they like the ads or not people will be talking about them, many will have an opinion on Jesus ... some will have questions?

The strength of the campaign is that it puts Jesus on the agenda with high quality media but this will be meaningless if we are not ready to engage with our friends and family over the issues it will raise.

1 Peter 3:15 says, *Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect.*

Over the next 10 weeks we need to be in prayer for this campaign and the opportunities it will provide. We need to become more familiar with Jesus, read again the gospel accounts of His life and ministry. We need to ask the Holy Spirit to equip us and prepare us to be ready.

The church leadership and the All about Life team will provide resources but it's up to each of us to prepare as best we can. Let's pray that as we joyfully share Jesus with Adelaide, that many will come to know Him as we do.

We would also like to hold a series of events around the theme. Please see me if you'd like to be involved.
